Main competition happens from July 15th for different categories, over the week-ends. We anticipate the Finals to be scheduled towards the end of August or early September.

The contest is open for non-Malayalee as well. However, Samajam will be happy if more Malayalee Hindus take part in these competitions to conserve our traditions and culture in our young generation. Hence request all members and well-wishers to make it a point to get the youth in your family to take part in at least one item.

There is a special prize for the winners in multiple talents, called *Kala Thilakam* and *Kala Prathibha*.

<u>Reception to Guru Mohanji</u>: On 14th April, during the eve of Vishu, Samajam had a special guest, Guru Mohanji. He was visiting his disciples in Singapore. Being a Malayalee from Palghat, he conveyed his interest to meet Malayalees on Vishu Day and Samajam arranged a get-together at Hindu Centre premises.

About 25 participants attended the Satsang and they were impressed by his knowledge and his style of delivering deep philosophical knowledge in simple Malayalam which is easy to understand. Samajam will be inviting Guruji to do such satsangs during his future visits to Singapore.



He had a full day retreat on Meditation on April 15th arranged by his disciples at Veerakaliamman temple which we understand was a grand success. We notice that more people are getting interested to learn and practice meditation.

<u>Sri Chakra Pua:</u> The Puja was conducted under the guidance of **Guru Karunamaya** on Saturday April 15th at Sri Sivan Temple Multipurpose Hall.

The participants were taught how to draw the Sri Chakram and they also participated in the correct methodology of performing the puja. We had 20 lady volunteers and 10 male volunteers who helped to draw the Sri Chakram under the guidance of Guru Karunamaya which took about 6 hours to complete. **The puja was performed in the evening**.


This is part of our Social activities for the benefit of the young members of the community. Participation was free but registration is compulsory. About 50 participants registered for the event.



President's Message:

We are publishing a Newsletter every month from the start of this year 2017. This is the 5th edition of the Hindu Samajam's newsletter. Thanks to all who sent us their feedback. Your support gives me the enthusiasm to keep in touch and do more for our community!

Present monthly revenue of Samajam is not sufficient to afford postage charges through Singpost. Hence we shall be posting it on our website. Members are requested to access the newsletter at www.hindusamajam.org >> click on the News Letters section.

Members who provide their e-mail ID will receive the newsletter via e-mail by the 5th of the month.

In the last 4 months, I had written on various subjects which are important to Malayalee Hindus in Singapore. <u>This</u> month, I wish to ask you all this important question:

Can we make the dream of a Kerala Style temple in Singapore a reality?

I think this is possible if the community stays together and get ready to support this project. It is estimated that there are about 7,500 Malayalee Hindu families in Singapore. This includes the expatriate community as well. We perform many religious services in Singapore such as marriage, housewarming, child naming ceremony, *chorroonu* etc. which require the service of a *namboodiri*. Krishnan namboodiri at Toa Payoh temple cannot handle this demand from the community in Singapore. As such, they are now using priests from other temples although the rituals do not match our Malayalee Hindu tradition.

Can we find a solution to avoid this compromise? I think YES! If each family here can commit an amount of \$\$100 per month for 10 months, we will be half way through to make this dream come true. If at least 3,000 community members extend their commitment to make a one-time contribution for a AYYAPPAN TEMPLE in Singapore, with Guruvayoorrappan and Bhagawathi as other deities, then **we will have \$3,000,000** as a committed initial fund to **make the dream TEMPLE a** reality to upkeep our Malayalee Hindu Temple traditions.

We are not collecting any money now. The Samajam is in the process of taking census to estimate the number of Malayalee Hindu families in Singapore. The process is to first build the database of Malayalee Hindus in Singapore and then prepare an estimate on the sponsorship and support we can get from the committee towards this cause. So, please register yourself and your family at the Samajam's website www.hindusamajam.org. Tick your willingness to contribute \$100 per month for 10 months or a higher amount towards your contribution. Please get all your Malayalee Hindu friends and family members also to register to the Samajam's database. We will request for your monthly contributions once the authorities give us permission to proceed with this project and to start collection of funds.

From our side, the MC shall also use all our events including **Yuvajanotsavam 2017** to spread this appeal to register at Samajam website. As the numbers grow, we shall organize events that benefit them, their children and family too. I am sure that will be a big step to get the children to follow the traditions you want them to follow. Once the desired numbers are reached, we can work on the dream temple project which will literally be a Temple of our traditions.

It is in your hands... please help. Let you be the first to register. Please do it today!
